### **DISCONTINUATION OF USING BAHASA MELAYU & MANDARIN IN RFP MODULE 1 & 2 EXAMINATION EFFECTIVE 1 JANUARY 2014**

With reference to the above, we are pleased to inform that the National Council of MFPC has agreed to standardise the usage of only English in RFP Module 1 & 2 examinations effective **1<sup>st</sup> January 2014** onwards instead to what is currently being practised having optional language Bahasa Melayu and Mandarin. This decision had been taken into consideration from the review over the past 4 years of the declining and very small number of participants in these two languages.

However, please be informed that optional language Bahasa Melayu and Mandarin is still applicable for student who register to re-sit examination by December 2014 .With this, we would like to urge for those who are interested to re-sit the examination in Bahasa Melayu & Mandarin to take prompt action for the above mentioned intakes.
